High Quality Online Professional Development

On a regular basis, *e-Learning Kentucky*, a component of **KY Virtual Schools**, provides facilitated and interactive online PD courses. Over 4000 Kentucky educators have improved their content knowledge and teaching practices, increased their students' achievement and practiced 21st Century skills.

Online SBDM Training

Facilitated by experienced and certified SBDM trainers, the training is available to individual council members (new and experienced), whole councils or interested individuals. SBDM training courses: SBDM Introduction to School Based Decision Making (3 or 6 hrs), SBDM Keys to Proficient Councils (3 hrs), SBDM Council Work and School Culture (3 hrs).

Online Communities of Practice

e-Learning Kentucky offers online collaborative workspaces for professional adults. These spaces allow participants to communicate effectively and share work without the constraints of meeting dates and times.

Online Facilitator and Course Designer Training

Annually, *e-Learning Kentucky* offers qualified KY educators an opportunity to participate in a 10-week online course to become a certified online facilitator or a 10-week course to learn to design online professional development courses. Qualified educators will receive a stipend for successfully completing the online training course and for completing additional requirements.
